

Information Bulletin for New Citizens of the Republic of Kanata

Issued July 1, 2019 by the Provisional Council for the Republic



Dear fellow Citizens,

Welcome to our Nation! You have taken the first step towards liberty by renouncing any ties or obligations to "Canada" and the Crown of England through your citizenship in the Republic of Kanata. You have thereby joined a growing community of people who are reclaiming and reimagining our nation from the grassroots.

As you are among the first of many new citizens, you carry a special opportunity and obligation to create Kanata and advance our common cause of making a constitutional Republic that serves all of the people. You will show by your own example how citizens in local Assemblies can formulate and enforce the laws that will govern them, police their communities and create a just and equal society. And you will be protected and strengthened in this effort by Republican Sheriffs and Militias who will help to safeguard your liberties and your lives.

Your Citizenship has given you these immediate freedoms and benefits:

1. The right to vote and run for public offices within local Republican Peoples' Assemblies and the General Congress, and to formulate, debate and pass laws in these bodies;

2. The right to attend as a delegate the first Constitutional Convention of the Republic;
3. The protection granted by the laws and security forces of the Republic within its national jurisdiction;
4. The power to lawfully arrest convicted or suspected criminals and enemies of the Republic and to reclaim their lands, properties and assets on behalf of the Republic;
5. The unrestricted right to free public transport, health care and financial restitution claimed under the Common Law Right of Reparations owed to the people by convicted genocidal regimes, and
6. The power to recruit, swear in as citizens, protect and train other citizens of the Republic.

These rights can only be secured by being actively practiced. It is not an amorphous state that is “giving” you these rights, for these are inborn liberties you are bestowing on yourself by performing them every day. You are the government.

As a new citizen, you are expected in return to do the following:

1. Join or help form a local Republican Peoples’ Assembly in your neighbourhood, and attend and participate in this Assembly regularly. *(The details of the Assembly and its associated Common Law Courts and Militias are described in our book Establishing Liberty: The Case for Kanata, a copy of which has been given to you as a new citizen.)*

2. Receive training to become an officer of the new Republic, either as an Assembly Convener, a Republican Sheriff , a Community Reclamation Project Convener or a Special Action Group member.
3. Financially contribute regularly to the new Republic and its Community Reclamation Projects.
4. Abide by the Laws and Constitution of the Republic, your Pledge of Citizenship, and any Oath of Public Office you take.

For now, it may be just you and a few other people in your community who constitute the citizens of the Republic. We expect our numbers to grow quickly once our example is shown, considering the depth of support among Canadians for the idea of a Republic. But in the short term, it is essential that the few of you organize yourselves into a local branch of Republican citizens under a local Convener, who stays in touch with the wider nation and our Provisional Council. This branch must meet weekly and plan local action, education and recruitment campaigns. Regional conveners will assist you in this organizing work.

In particular, we urge one of you to undergo immediate training to become a Republican Sheriff, who is the front line officer of the new Republic. The Sheriff has the lawful right to convene Common Law Courts, organize local Militias and safeguard the local Peoples' Assembly of twelve or more people. Each of you must take personal responsibility for your own mutual defense and security, with the direct assistance of our wider movement and Nation.

To further this effort, our Regional Conveners will meet with you and hold New Citizen Training Workshops to help you consolidate your core leadership group. The wider populace will be drawn into our new Nation once local Peoples' Assemblies are up and running. But the handful of new citizens must first be made solid and trusting among themselves if they are to gather more people around them and be persistent in building the new Republic.

No doubt you will have many questions and the lessons of your own experience to share with us. We are all learning and struggling together as citizens of a true Republic of Equals. Your work and insights are invaluable and need to be shared with the entire Nation and our burgeoning Nation. So don't hesitate to jump in and seize the reins of the Republic!

In the words of Samuel Adams, the American Revolutionary Republican,

"It is not necessary for a majority to prevail, but only a resolute minority of people who are determined to light brushfires of freedom in the minds of men and women." (1772)

So carry it on, friends. Help us light the world on fire! And long live the Republic of Kanata!
